






A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Plano, Texas, designating the name of the new Oak Point Park building as the Oak Point Park Nature and Retreat Center and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Oak Point Park and Nature Preserve was purchased for the purpose of serving the citizens of Plano as an open space preserve; and

WHEREAS, the park site is planned to include a nature and retreat center building; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Plano is solely responsible for naming all City-owned facilities, structures and improvements, whether natural or manmade, including but not limited to buildings, parks, and recreational facilities located within the City of Plano.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. The City Council of the City of Plano hereby designates the name of the new Oak Point Park building as the Oak Point Park Nature and Retreat Center.

Section II. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
