
2015 Plano Police Department Performance Measure #1 Crime Rate

1. **Violent crimes per 1,000 down 2.9% ↓**
2. **Property crimes per 1,000 down 5.7% ↓**

10-Year Comparison




2015 Plano Police Department Performance Measure #1 Crime Rate

- Violent crimes per 1,000 down 2.9% from 2014 ↓
 - Homicides unchanged at 4
 - Rapes up at 94 (10.6% above 3-year average of 85) ↑
 - Robberies down 28.5% from 158 to 113 ↓
 - Aggravated Assaults up 6.9% from 204 to 218 ↑

10-Year Comparison




2015 Plano Police Department Performance Measure #1 Crime Rate

- Property crimes per 1,000 down 5.7% ↓
 - Residential burglaries down 13.9% ↓
 - Non-residential burglaries down 4.4% ↓
 - Larceny down 4.9% ↓
 - Motor Vehicle Thefts up 10.0% ↑

2015 Plano Police Department Performance Measure #2 Traffic Safety

- Total crashes per 1,000 up 11.2% ↑
 - Crashes on US 75 are up 26% from 2014
 - Crashes along the three tollways are up 36% (including service roads)
 - Impact of construction projects
 - Increased traffic volume
 - Reductions in traffic stops and enforcement







10-Year Comparison





10-Year Comparison






Response Times (All Calls)

2015 Plano Police Department Performance Measures Summary

- Lowest crime rate in Plano since 1980
 - For 2014, Plano also had the lowest crime rate in Texas for cities with a population over 200,000*
- Crashes, crashes with injuries, and fatality crashes have increased
- Response times remain low and exceed our goal
- Overall, quality of service ratings have increased and consistently remain outstanding
