- Fix it Plano program
- Parks and Recreation Center Updates

  - Carpenter Recreation Center Reopening

The Council will receive public comment and inquiry on items of interest that are not posted on the current agenda. Council and/or staff may respond to those items with factual information or recitation of existing policy related to the inquiry or comment. It may not deliberate on the matters brought forward because those items have not been posted; however, the Council may decide to place the item(s) on a future agenda. The Mayor may limit the speaking time in order to provide sufficient time for all inquiries.

This meeting will focus on District 2, the boundaries of which are: North – City's Limit; South - City's Limit; West – City's Limit; East – Coit (from northern City's Limit to Spring Creek), Preston (from Spring Creek to Park) and Ohio (from Park to southern City's Limit).
