

## PLANO CITY COUNCIL

**WILL CONVENE INTO A SPECIAL CALLED SESSION AT 5:00 P.M., MAY 20, 2013, IN THE PLANO MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 1520 K AVENUE, IN COMPLIANCE WITH VERNON'S TEXAS CODES ANNOTATED, GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 551 (OPEN MEETINGS ACT), AS FOLLOWS:**

**Mission Statement:** The City of Plano is a regional and national leader, providing outstanding services and facilities through cooperative efforts that engage our citizens and contribute to the quality of life in our community.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-\_\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_(R)

A RESOLUTION canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the bond election held May 11, 2013.

WHEREAS, an election was held in the City of Plano, Texas on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013, for the purpose of submitting certain propositions for the issuance of bonds to the resident electors of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election;

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby acknowledges that the returns of said election have been duly and legally made and submitted to it for canvassing and that it has received and reviewed a tabulation of the returns for each polling place and for early voting, as canvassed and tabulated by this governing body in accordance with applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, including, without limitation, Section 67.004(b) thereof (the "Official Canvass Report"); and

WHEREAS, the summary of the Official Canvass Report contained in Exhibit A attached hereto and the Official Canvass Report reflect that the total sum of votes counted "FOR" and "AGAINST" the propositions submitted are as follows:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: All of the recitals contained in the preamble of this resolution are found to be true and are adopted as findings of fact by this governing body and as part of its judgment.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-\_\_\_\_-\_\_\_\_(R)

SECTION 2: It is further found and determined that the results of the election are as canvassed and tabulated in the preamble hereof and as summarized in **Exhibit A** attached hereto, and, a majority of the resident qualified electors voting at said election having voted in favor of the propositions numbered 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, the City Council is hereby declared to be authorized and empowered to issue the bonds on behalf of the City in the amount and for the purposes stated in said propositions numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4 all as more fully set forth and identified above and in the proceedings calling said election. The City's authority to issue the unissued general obligation bonds pursuant to Proposition No. 7 of the bond election held within the City on May 2, 1998 is revoked.

SECTION 3: The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to make the appropriate entries of information appearing in the tabulation of precinct results shown in the Official Canvass Report as summarized in **Exhibit A** attached hereto in the election register maintained by the City in accordance with provisions of Section 67.004(b) and Section 67.006 of the Election Code.
