

PLANO CITY COUNCIL

WILL CONVENE INTO SPECIAL CALLED SESSION AT 6:00 P.M., NOVEMBER 16, 2011, IN THE PLANO MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 1520 K AVENUE, IN COMPLIANCE WITH VERNON'S TEXAS CODES ANNOTATED, GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 551 (OPEN MEETINGS ACT), AS FOLLOWS:

Mission Statement: The mission of the City of Plano is to provide outstanding services and facilities, through cooperative efforts with our citizens, that contribute to the quality of life in our community.

Special Called Session

- I. **Resolution No. 2011-11-18(R)** of the City Council of the City of Plano, Texas, canvassing the election returns of the Special Election held on November 8, 2011, at which were submitted three amendments to the City Charter of the City of Plano affecting Section 1.02 of Article 1; Section 2.02 of Article 2; Sections 3.01, 3.02, and 3.06, of Article 3; Sections 4.04 and 4.07 of Article 4; Section 5.01 of Article 5; Sections 6.03, 6.07 and 6.11 of Article 6; Section 7.02 of Article 7; Sections 8.01 and 8.03 of Article 8; Section 9.06 and 9.14 of Article 9; Sections 10-A.02, 10.02, 10.04 and 10.11 of Article 10; and Sections 11.01, 11.04 and 11.11 of Article 11 of the Charter; declaring the results of such election; declaring that each proposition which was approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting in such election shall become a part of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Plano; authorizing the taking of all acts required as a result of the adoption of such charter amendments; and declaring the effective date of this resolution. **(Adopted)**

- II. **Resolution No. 2011-11-19(R)** of the City Council of the City of Plano, Texas, appointing the Chief Municipal Judge and associate judges of the Plano Municipal Court, setting the terms of office for the judges; and providing an effective date. **(Adopted)**

In accordance with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, during Special Called Sessions, agenda items will be discussed and votes may be taken where appropriate. The City Council may convene into Executive Session to discuss posted items in the session as allowed by law.
