**THE CITY OF PLANO CITY COUNCIL WILL HOLD A NEIGHBORHOOD ROUNDTABLE ON THURSDAY, AUGUST 18, 2005 BEGINNING AT 7:00 P.M., AT VINES HIGH SCHOOL CAFETERIA, 1401 HIGHEDGE DRIVE, IN PLANO, TEXAS.**

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss neighborhood concerns and ideas, and answer questions regarding city services and programs. This meeting will focus on District 4, boundaries which are: North – Spring Creek; South – City’s Limit; East – Alma; and to the West, Coit (from Spring Creek to Parker) and Ohio (from Parker to southern City’s Limit).

A brief budget presentation regarding the City of Plano’s proposed 2005-06 Program of Service will be made at the opening of this neighborhood roundtable meeting.
